

# **BLAIR WOODLAND** **NATURAL AREA**

## **Owned by the Town of Campton**

The 17 acre piece was given as a gift in 2002 to be kept as a natural area for wildlife and the general public for “low impact” uses such as nature study and enjoyment while walking, snowshoeing, or fishing; to name a few.

The land is totally forested with a variety of tree types and wildlife habitats.

It has about 1000 feet of river frontage and is accessible from Rt. 3, just south of the Blair Road intersection and The Red Sleigh.

The Conservation Commission has created public access to the property, fitting the restrictions made by the donor. Grant monies were applied for and awarded through the NH “moose plate” program to fund the project. A parking area was cleared and completed, a trail kiosk was built, trails were designed and built and a trail guide was written.

Enjoyment of the natural environment in all seasons is welcomed.
