

MINUTES

SELECTMEN'S MEETING

April 25, 2016

The Board of Selectmen met for their weekly meeting at 6:30 p.m. at the Campton Municipal Building. Present were Selectmen, Karl Kelly and Charles Wheeler, and Carina Park, Town Administrator and Eleanor Dewey, Office Assistant (recorder).

Selectman Wheeler explained that they needed one more Board member present to make a quorum and they would wait a few minutes for one more member of the Board. At 7:00 p.m. it was explained to the public that because they did not have a quorum they could only carry on with discussion.

Selectman Wheeler called on Brian Gallagher who had an appointment with the Board this evening. Mr. Gallagher introduced himself and explained that he will be campaigning for State Senate since there is a Senate seat open due to Jeannie Forrester's decision to run for Governor. Mr. Gallagher gave a brief description of his background which involved, finance, the administrative system in the Supreme Court and then he moved on to education in the Bristol area for eight years and the Windham area for two years. He explained he is a conservative, but is willing to listen in order to make decisions that "make sense" for all concerned. Selectman Kelly inquired if there were any questions. There were none and Selectman Wheeler and Selectman Kelly thanked Mr. Gallagher for coming this evening.

Selectman Wheeler called on John Timson regarding a debris issue at the cemetery which was discussed at the Meeting on April 11, 2016. Mr. Timson explained that he has been putting debris in the hole (off to the side of the cemetery) each year to keep the bank from eroding and it has helped. However, he has now removed the debris in question. The Selectmen present this evening inquired if Mr. Timson needed some material to support the bank and Mr. Timson stated he did not. Selectman Kelly thanked Mr. Timson for resolving the issue. Mr. Timson also mentioned that there are dog waste issues at the cemetery and he suggested that dogs not be allowed at the cemetery. Selectman Wheeler explained that when they have a full Board present they will discuss this matter.

Selectman Wheeler inquired if there was any further discussion. There was none and all present excused themselves.
