ZONING BOARD OF ADJUSTMENT
MEETING, MAY 12, 2016
MINUTES

May 12, 2016

The Zoning Board of Adjustment met this date with Sam Plaisted, Chairman, Tim Scanlon, and Martha Aguiar.

Sam Plaisted opened the meeting at 6:30 PM.

First on the agenda, the minutes for the February 11, 2016 Zoning Board of Adjustment meeting. Tim Scanlon made a motion to approve the February 11, 2016 minutes as amended. Martha Aguiar seconded the motion. The Zoning Board of Adjustment voted in the affirmative, unanimously.

Next on the agenda, The Bank of NH is requesting two variances:

1. To allow for a replacement panel for Community Guaranty Savings, to be installed for the Bank of New Hampshire, which includes internal illumination. The proposed sign will then match the existing Dunkin Donuts sign.
2. Regarding the existing free standing sign, the Bank of New Hampshire proposes no change to the illumination. They are requesting the continuation of the existing sign lighting, which is ground lighting, instead of requiring the added expense of lighting this new sign from the top.

Tom Sullivan from Barlo Signs, is representing The Bank of New Hampshire stated that the existing free standing sign with the ground mounted spot light is on a smaller footprint. Mr. Sullivan also stated that they need the extra lighting for the 24 hour ATMs. Sam Plaisted said that the signage is all about the same size as the Community Guaranty Bank signs. The Zoning Board did not see any problems with the variances that were requested. The Zoning Board of Adjustment voted in the affirmative, unanimously, to approve the variances requested by the Bank of New Hampshire.

The Zoning Board of Adjustment adjourned at 7 PM.
