

250th Celebration Committee

November 10, 2016

Present were Ann Verow, Carol Lenahan, Martha Aguiar, Paul Yelle, Mary O'Brien, Jess Helm and Sharon Davis.

Sharon reported that the Conservation Commission was very excited about having the celebration at the Pattee Field, and Jess Helm, a Conservation Commissioner, came to the meeting to confirm the Commission's approval. It was agreed that Jess would get more involved with the celebration event in a few months after the Committee has more information on what the events will be. Jess did advise that 2017 is the next year for mowing the field which takes place in early fall. There was also a short discussion about porta potties, generators, etc.

Carol then provided the Committee with a plan for celebration banners. She provided the Committee with a sample of a banner and she advised that Lisa Lungari, artist, was willing to work with us on the design and Megaprint would print the banners. It was decided to budget for 30 banners 4 of which to be paid for by committee funds with CAMPTONNH.ORG imprinted on them. Costs: artwork (\$300.), 4 banners with CAMPTONNH.ORG @84. each (\$336.), and (30) bracket kits for 30 banners @26.00 + 4.00 shpg. (\$30. ea)=\$900.), totalling \$1536. This figure will be reduced by \$120 by Steve Rand as he is also ordering brackets at the same time and will reimburse the committee. It was decided to offer banners to business for \$150.00.

Sharon will talk with Carina Park, Town Administrator, and Ron Reynolds, a town volunteer, about establishing a 250th Celebration page on the town's web site.

Sharon advised that the Old Home Day account had a balance of around \$2,800.00 which could be used to get the banners started.

Next meeting will include listing of possible events so that the Committee can start moving in a direction to developing formal plans. It is hoped that more citizens will get involved so that the event will be a success.
