

MINUTES

SELECTMEN'S MEETING

November 22, 2019

The Campton Board of Selectmen met at 9:00 am at the Campton Municipal Building. Present were Chair Craig Keeney, Selectman Karl Kelly, Selectman Sharon Davis, Selectman Bill Cheney, and Selectman Dan Boynton. Town Administrator Carina Park and Town Clerk/Tax Collector Hannah Joyce were also present. During the work session, the Board signed the vendor manifest, appointment paperwork and a property tax abatement.

Call to Order: Chair Keeney called the meeting to order at 9:10 am.

New Business:

2019 Tax Rate

The Board reviewed the preliminary tax rate from the NH Department of Revenue. The preliminary tax rate was set at \$23.32. After discussion regarding the recent revaluation of the town and the approximate percentage in increased value, the Board agreed to use \$50,000.00 from the Unassigned Fund Balance to reduce the preliminary rate to \$23.21.

Selectman Davis made a motion to use the unassigned fund balance to reduce the municipal portion of the tax rate from \$5.22 to \$5.11. Selectman Cheney seconded and the Board voted unanimously in favor. The motion carries.

Town Administrator Carina Park presented the formal documents for the Board to sign.

Adjournment: There being no further business, Chair Keeney declared the meeting adjourned at 9:50 a.m.
