ORDINANCE RELATIVE TO DEPOSITING OF SNOW ONTO ROADWAYS

No. 19-0001

Intent: To promote the safe and orderly passage of the motoring public on the Town of Campton's roads, free from obstructions and obstacles created by the removal or depositing of snow, the Town of Campton hereby adopts the following ordinance on February 11, 2019.

Ordinance: Pursuant to and with direction from RSA 236:20, RSA 47:17, VII, and RSA 41:11, it shall be unlawful to plow, snow blow or otherwise cause the movement of snow onto any and all Town roads, including Class V and VI, or to deposit snow within the traveled portion of town roads.


Definition:

Traveled Portion – shall mean any part of the roadway in which vehicles would travel, including the shoulders of said roadway.


Penalty: Violators of this Ordinance shall be fined a minimum of \$100 for a first offense and \$500 for a second or subsequent offense, which occurs within 2 years of the prior offense
