

TOWN OF CAMPTON
PLANNING BOARD MEETING
AUGUST 11, 2015
MINUTES

The Planning Board met this date with Stuart Pitts, Chairman, Greg Jencks, Secretary, Charles Brosseau, Chris Kelly, Tim Scanlon, and Karl Kelly, Ex-Officio.

Stuart Pitts opened the meeting at 6:30 PM.

First on the agenda, the minutes for the July 14, 2015 Planning Board meeting. Charles Brosseau made a motion to approve the minutes for the July 14, 2015 Planning Board meeting. Chris Kelly seconded the motion. The Planning Board voted in the affirmative, unanimously.

Next on the agenda, the Work Session notes for the August 4, 2015 Planning Board meeting. Chris Kelly made a motion to approve the Work Session notes for the August 4, 2015 Planning Board meeting. Charles Brosseau seconded the motion. The Planning Board voted in the affirmative, unanimously.

Next on the agenda, John March for White Mountain Oil & Propane Site Plan Review. John said that the Johnsons wish to sell a 6.27 acre parcel to White Mountain Oil & Propane. This parcel abuts their existing property, which is a propane storage facility. White Mountain Oil & Propane plan on constructing a 4 bay garage for their trucks. They will not be putting up any additional propane storage tanks at this time. John said that White Mountain Oil & Propane attorneys are working on an easement for the shared driveway. Eric Johnson wanted to know if they were going to cut trees around the lot. John said that there would be minimal tree cutting. Eric Johnson also wanted to know if they had plans in the future of adding more propane storage tanks. John said that they were waiting to see if there is a demand for more propane, as Yeaton Oil & Propane from Plymouth, was just bought out by another company. Stuart said that they should check with the Fire Chief to see if he has any concerns. Charles Brosseau made a motion to approve the White Mountain Oil and Propane Site Plan Review. Greg Jencks seconded the motion. The Planning Board voted in the affirmative, unanimously.
