Bill's update on solar power planning - After meeting with folks from ReVision, several hangups have been identified. There is no good place for panels on the town campus as currently configured. The buildings are not properly aligned and no ground space has been identified. They have looked at the water precinct and placement there would require routing power through Eversource lines costing substantial payment (30%). Discussions will be ongoing with the town.

Charrette - Nik Coates says that we are still waiting approval on our application. Also, town is looking for sources of funding in case the grants aren't approved.

NH Community Power – continued discussing this. We reviewed what we were told at our last meeting. Also Bill provided additional input. We think this is still a good idea but we are not yet planning to move forward until we get further data other operational community power programs.

Public Health. Identification of the most vulnerable. All present, see quorum from above, voted to work on the identification of the most vulnerable. Hopefully this will be linked with a newly developed Public Health Emergency Task Force that the town might be creating, building a database, hotline, and wellness checks.
